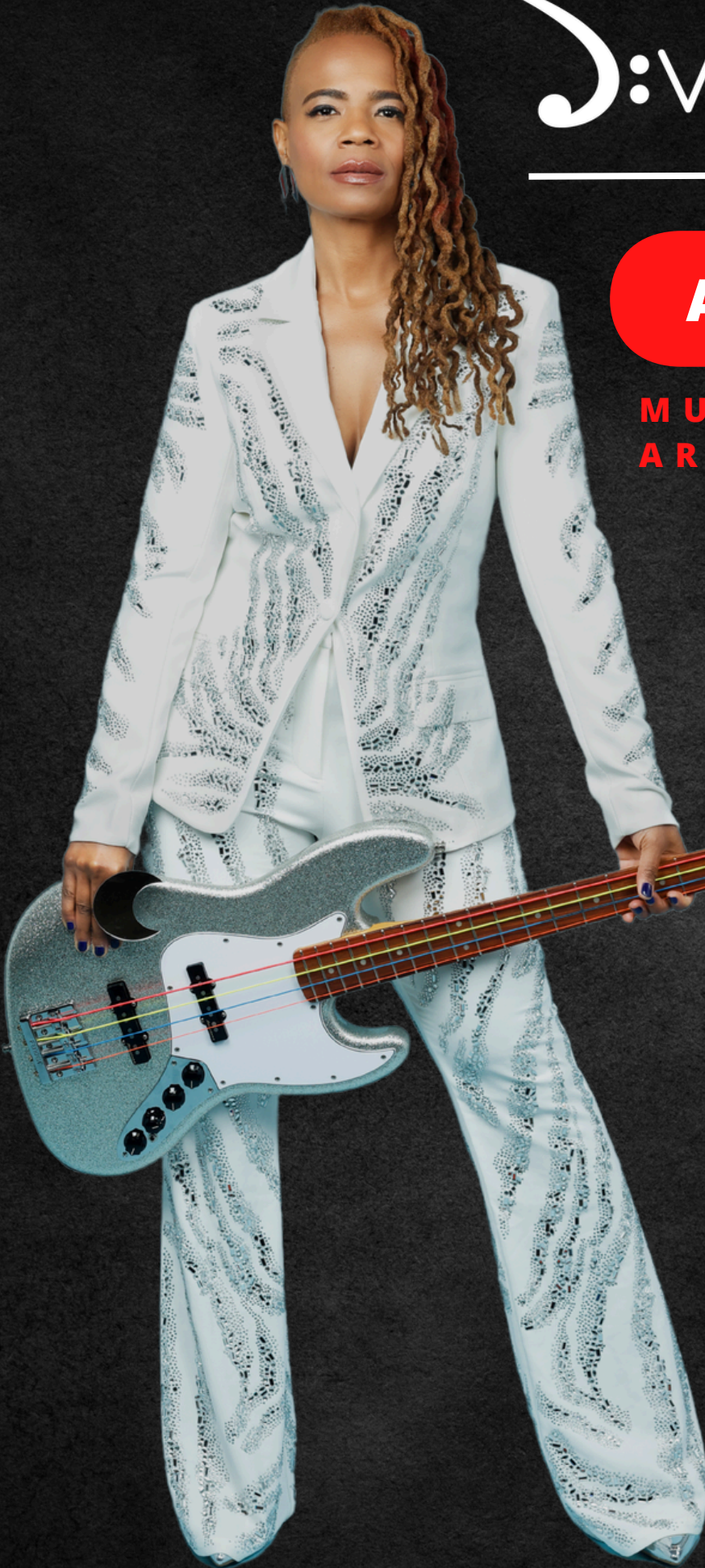

DIVINITY ROXX IS A 2X GRAMMY-NOMINATED, MULTI-HYPHENATE AWARD-WINNING MUSICIAN, RECORDING ARTIST, AND COMPOSER WHO IS CELEBRATED FOR HER DYNAMIC STYLE AND INNOVATIVE APPROACH.




Divinity Roxx is a two-time Grammy®-nominated artist, composer, and author whose career defines the intersection of virtuosity and versatile storytelling. A world-class bassist and musical director, her professional foundation was forged in high-stakes collaboration, recording and touring globally with five-time Grammy winner Victor Wooten before spending years as the bassist and Musical Director for Beyoncé, captivating global audiences and elevating the profile of female touring musicians on the world's largest stages.

Her work as a composer and performer extends into the theater and television. Divinity is the composer and performer of the theme song for the hit PBS Kids series, *Lyla in the Loop*, showcasing her ability to blend infectious rhythm with educational narrative. Her theatrical credits include co-composing the original score for the critically acclaimed stage production *The Boy Who Kissed the Sky*, and composing anew work for the *Peter Rabbit* franchise. She also wrote and starred in her autobiographical one-woman show, *Starchild: The Ballad of Debbie Walker*. Her screen presence includes a featured appearance in a national NY Lotto commercial, and the HBO Documentary, 'Happy and You Know It'. Her distinct vocal talent is showcased in her voice-over work for television and radio commercials, and major audio cinema projects like *Elfquest*.

As the creator of *Divi Roxx Kids*, she has earned two Grammy nominations for family music, and further expanded her reach through multiple titles with Scholastic, adapting her rhythmic compositions into celebrated children's books.

A dedicated advocate for the creative community, Divinity serves as a Trustee for The Recording Academy and a mentor for Grammy U, championing digital sovereignty and fair compensation for artists. Whether performing at The White House, appearing on *Saturday Night Live*, or leading workshops through her D.R.E.A.M. framework, Divinity Roxx remains a powerhouse of innovation, dedicated to the mastery of her craft and the empowerment of the next generation.

BIOGRAPHY

Divinity Roxx is a 2X Grammy-nominated, multi-hyphenate recording artist, and composer who is celebrated for her inspirational lyrics and infectious grooves. After her debut performance at Kidzapalooza in 2023 the Chicago Sun-Times heralded her as a "true kid idol."

Her career as a bass player and performer skyrocketed after touring with the 5-time Grammy Award-winning bass virtuoso Victor Wooten. She then toured and performed with Beyoncé as her bassist and Musical Director. She was a featured soloist on tour and composed original music for the I...AM Sasha Fierce tour and DVD. She has appeared on countless television shows including SNL, Good Morning America, The Grammy's, and more, with personal highlights including a live performance at The White House Easter Egg Roll in 2023.

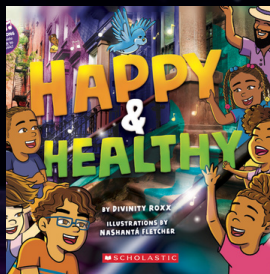
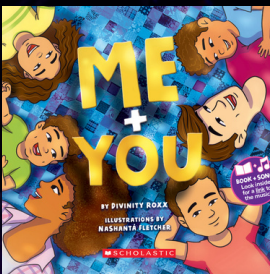
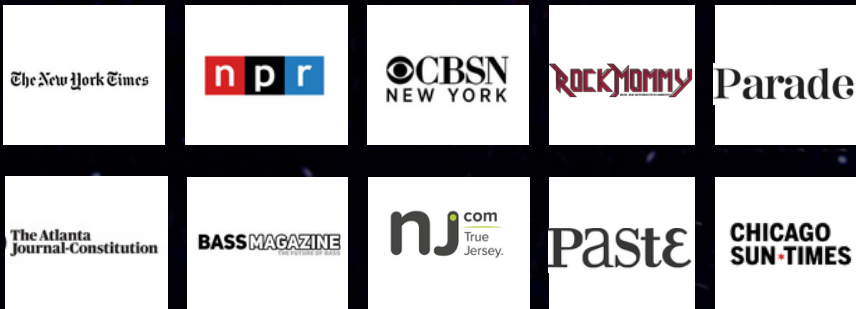
Divinity created 'Divi Roxx Kids' to further her mission to inspire and empower young people through music, edutainment, and storytelling. Her debut, full-length Family Music album 'Ready Set Go!' was nominated for Best Children's Music Album at the 65th Annual Grammy Awards. Scholastic Inc. published two songs from 'Ready Set Go!' as fully illustrated picture books.

Divinity co-composed original music and lyrics for the Young Theatre of the Arts play, 'The Boy Who Kissed The Sky' (Idris Goodwin), a co-production between the Tony Award-winning Alliance Theater (Atlanta) and Seattle Children's Theater and a special production of 'Peter Rabbit: Into The Burrow' with The Alliance Theatre. She composed, produced, and performed the theme song for the PBS Kids television show, "Lyla in the Loop".

Divinity was born in Atlanta, GA, and lives in New Jersey where she continues to compose, produce and create. She is working on a new Family album as well as a series of theatre and book projects.
